## Foreword

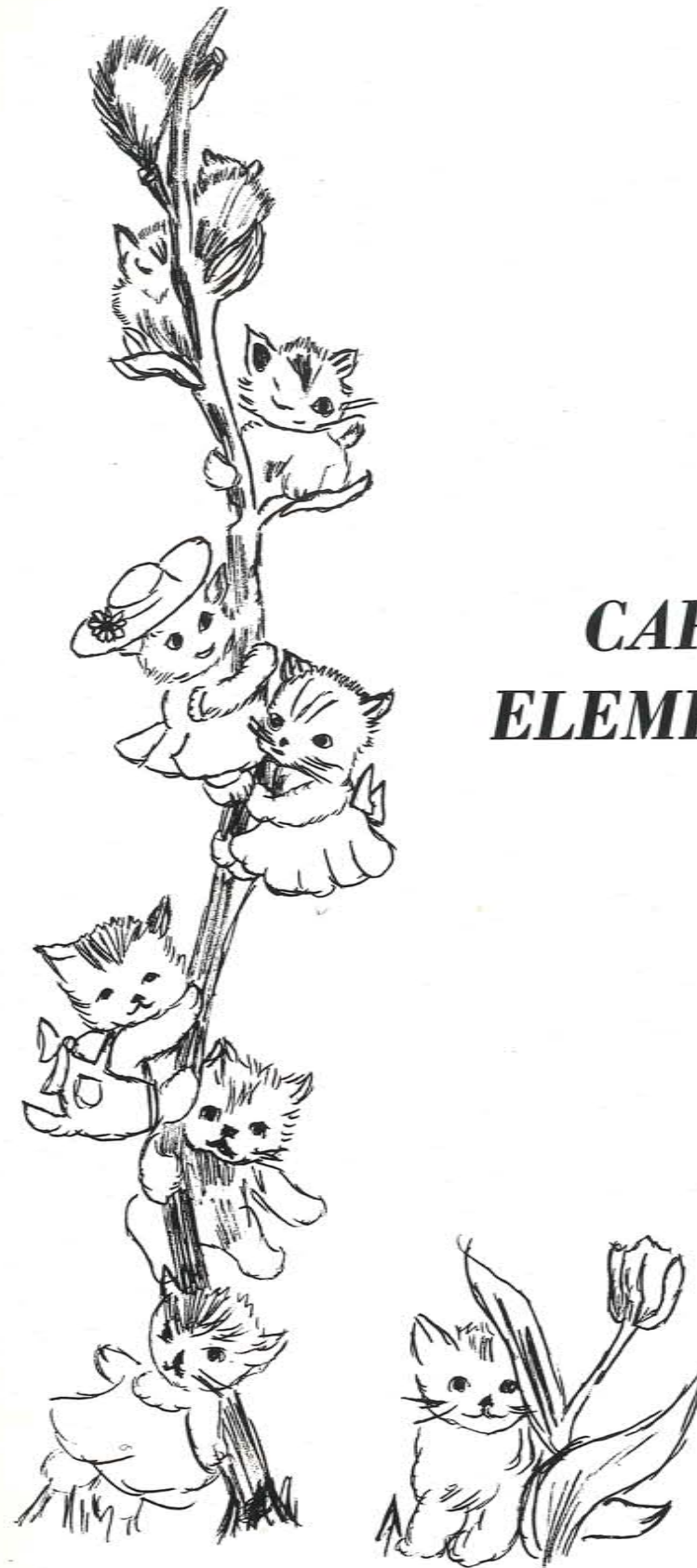

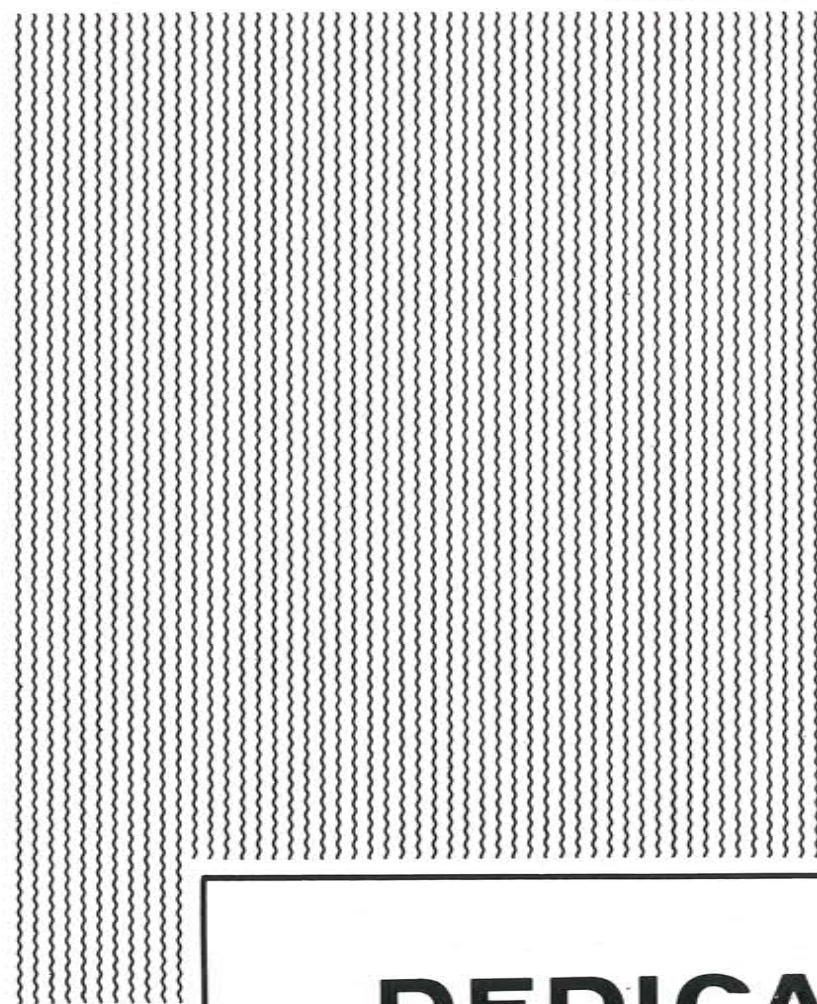

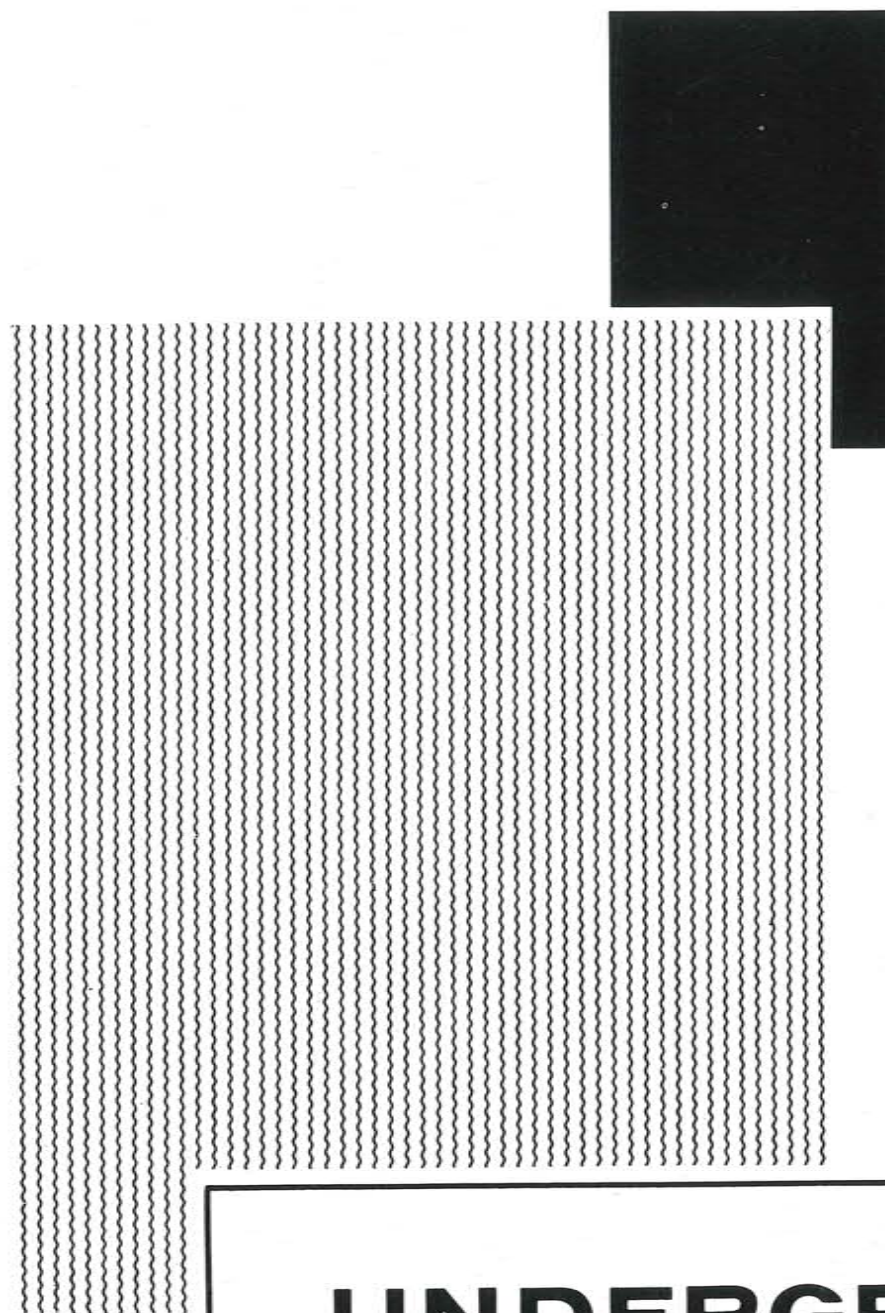


# DEDICATION
