Here the sought-for goal is conditioned on the two fundamental ideas of doing one's best wherever he is and in trusting an all-wise Providence for the final direction. In Holy Writ we read, "I will instruct you and teach you what is the road to take." Ps. 32:8 (Moffitt).

Bryant in his poem "To A Waterfowl," captured the idea thus:

"He who, from zone to zone,
Guides through the boundless sky thy certain flight,
In the long way that I must tread alone,
Will lead my steps aright."

As you do your best may such a confidence and trust as is expressed in these lines be yours, is the sincere wish of your friend and principal.
