Pastor's Message

In Matthew 25:1-13 we have a parable that is worthy of our attention. As Christ and His disciples watched a waiting bridal party, the parable was taught them by the Master Teacher. Lingered near the bride's house were ten young women robed in white, whom Christ used to represent His waiting, watching church. Because His people professed a pure faith, they were represented by virgins. Jeremiah 6:2. They each have lamps, representing the word of God. Ps. 119:105. They have a knowledge of the Scriptures and rejoice in its truth. Zechariah 4. All had oil in their lamps, but only five had oil in their vessels. The difference between the two classes was that five had the blessed presence of the Holy Spirit and the other five did not. The foolish were not hypocrites, for they had heard and accepted with joy the message of Christ's near approach and they confidently awaited His appearing; but like the stony-ground hearers of another parable, they were not prepared for the crisis of waiting, and it is in a time of crisis that true character is revealed. The foolish virgins had not been content with a faulty doctrine, but with a superficial work of grace in their lives; and when the coming of the darkest hour brought the bridegroom, they were unprepared for him, though they had made preparation for nothing else in their lives. They recognized the voice of the bridegroom, showing that they could distinguish between the true and the false, but they were not personally ready. It was the extra oil the five virgins had in their vessels, not the amount they had in the burning lamps, that made the difference between them. There will be many times, friends, when you will need to draw from the surplus, and this surplus will prove your only safety. No amount of trimming the lamps will compensate for a shortage of oil. The Christian must be ready to meet and master the unexpected. The one who rises to victory is the one who is not conquered by surprises; he has enough by having more than enough. May all of us live so close to Jesus and be so full of the Holy Spirit that Heaven will be our home. I'll see you there!

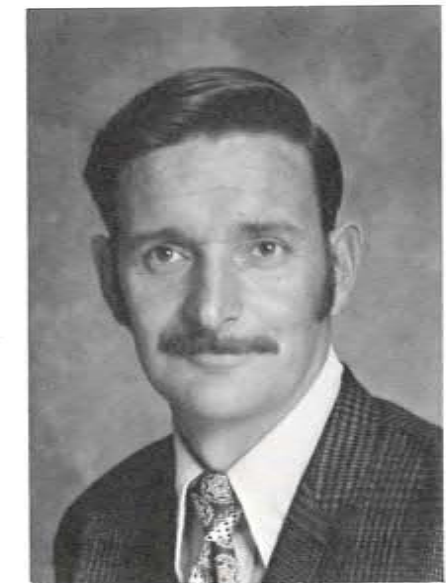
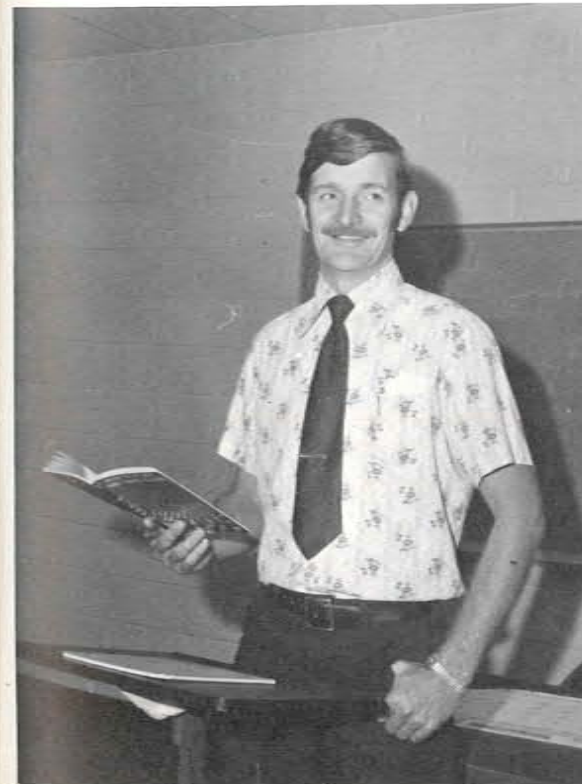
I think of the promise in Ezekiel 36:27 where God promises to put His Spirit within us, causing us to accomplish that which He commands, and to be that which He expects us to be.

In Appreciation

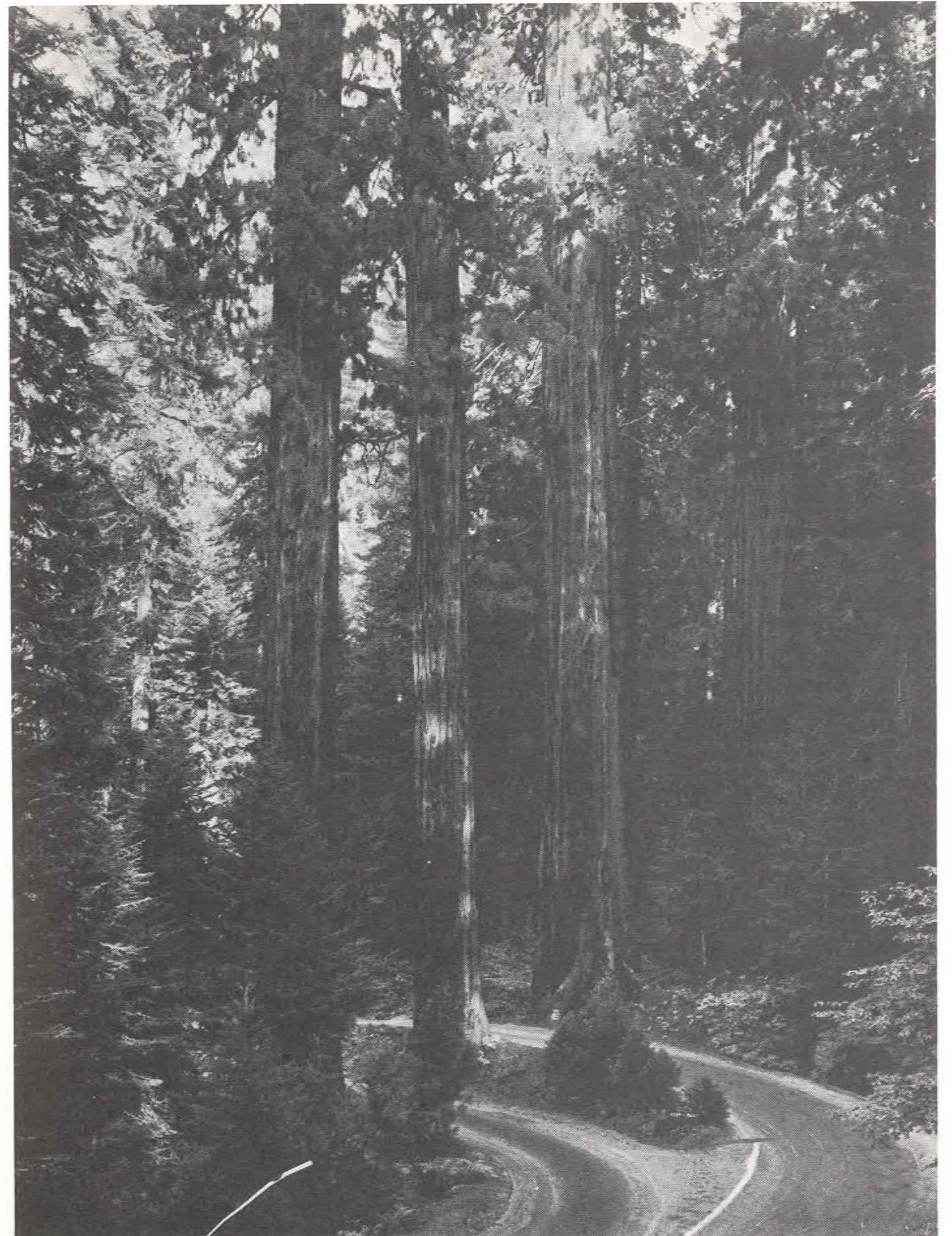
