MESSAGE



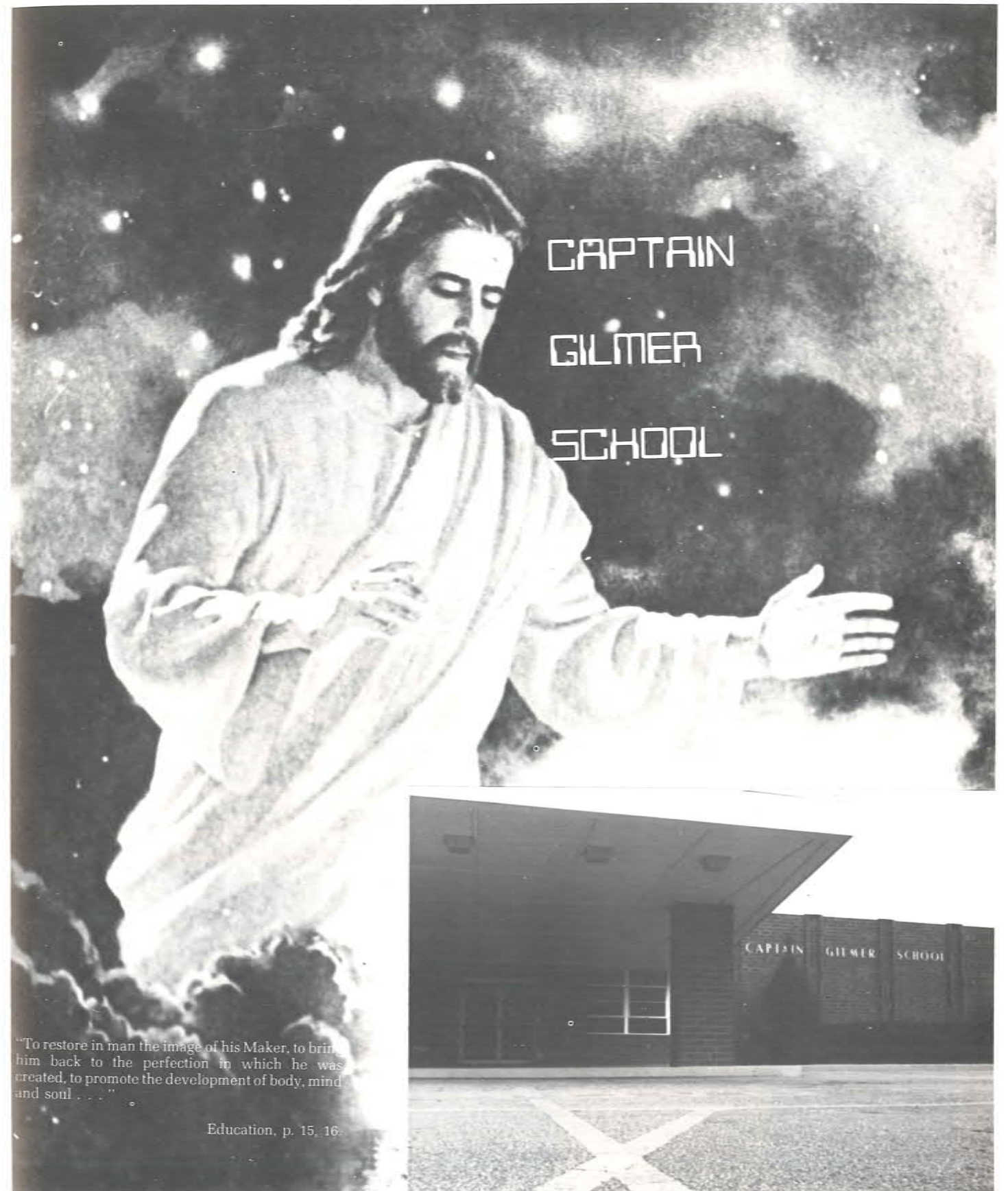

Dear Students:

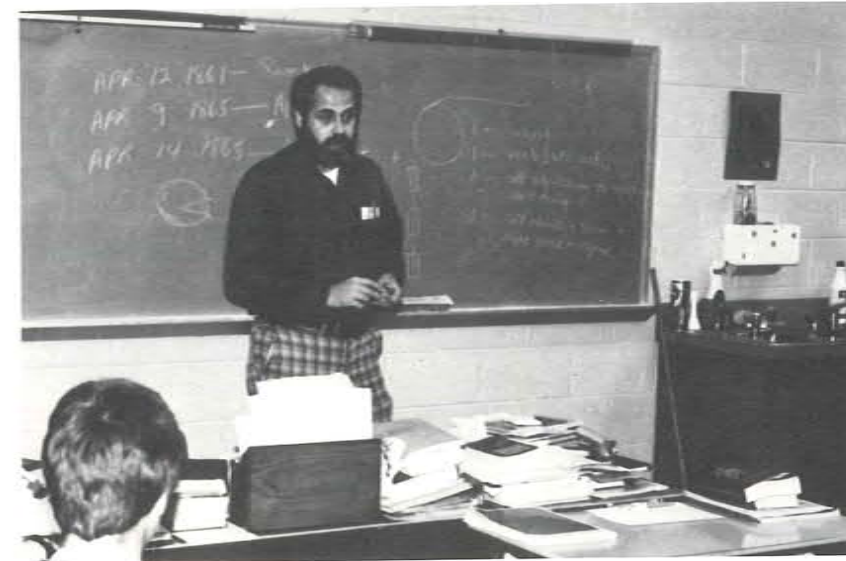

HE HEARS A DIFFERENT DRUMMER

Henry David Thoreau (1817-1862), an American writer, made the following plea for tolerance and understanding: "If a man does not keep pace with his companions, perhaps it is because he hears a different drummer. Let him step to the music which he hears, however measured or far away." At the time Thoreau wrote these words, it was customary for soldiers to march to the beat of a drummer. So long as they heard the drummer and marched accordingly, they would be able to keep pace with each other in an orderly and disciplined manner.

HE HEARS A DIFFERENT DRUMMER

Thoreau, of course, was not referring to a military person when he wrote those words, but was speaking in more general or philosophical terms about a person who does not conform to popular patterns of living. There is reason to believe that he consciously or unconsciously was speaking about himself. For in 1845, he moved to the shore of Walden Pond near Concord, Mass. and there he lived alone for a little over two years. In 1854 he wrote WALDEN, a book about man living in harmony with nature. Thoreau understood his trip to Walden Pond as an experiment in simple living and appealed to his readers to economize and lead less complicated lives. In his thinking, he was original and individualistic, in his behavior, a nonconformist.

His plea for tolerance did not prevent him from attempting to persuade others to think and behave the way he did. In 1849 he published an essay entitled "Civil Disobedience" in which he argued that the individual should disobey any government rule he believes is unjust. He in fact practiced this doctrine in 1845 when he refused to pay poll taxes in an effort to express his opposition to slavery. Because of his refusal, he spent the night in jail.

It is not always easy to tolerate a person who thinks and acts differently from us. The nonconformist can be annoying and disruptive. And yet, he often is a gifted person who is able to look beyond our present horizons and see the long range results of our present way of living. He is the modern day prophet who forecasts doom and destruction in order to persuade us to preserve our natural resources, to purify our environment, and to purge our nation of the social evils that pervade our society.

In some respects, Fletcher Academy is a nonconformist institution. The learning experience you receive here is much different from the learning experience you would receive in public schools throughout our nation. We like to think that our school is superior to the public school. But this may not always be true. Insofar as our school is organized around the spiritual values of our church, we believe our students will have opportunities to develop themselves physically, intellectually, morally, and spiritually in ways not possible in a school system with different values. Whether or not the nonconformist tradition of Fletcher Academy is all that we hope it to be will, of course, be determined by the students when they assume positions of leadership and service in their communities.
