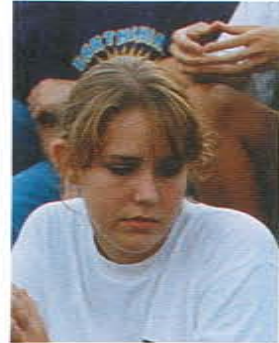

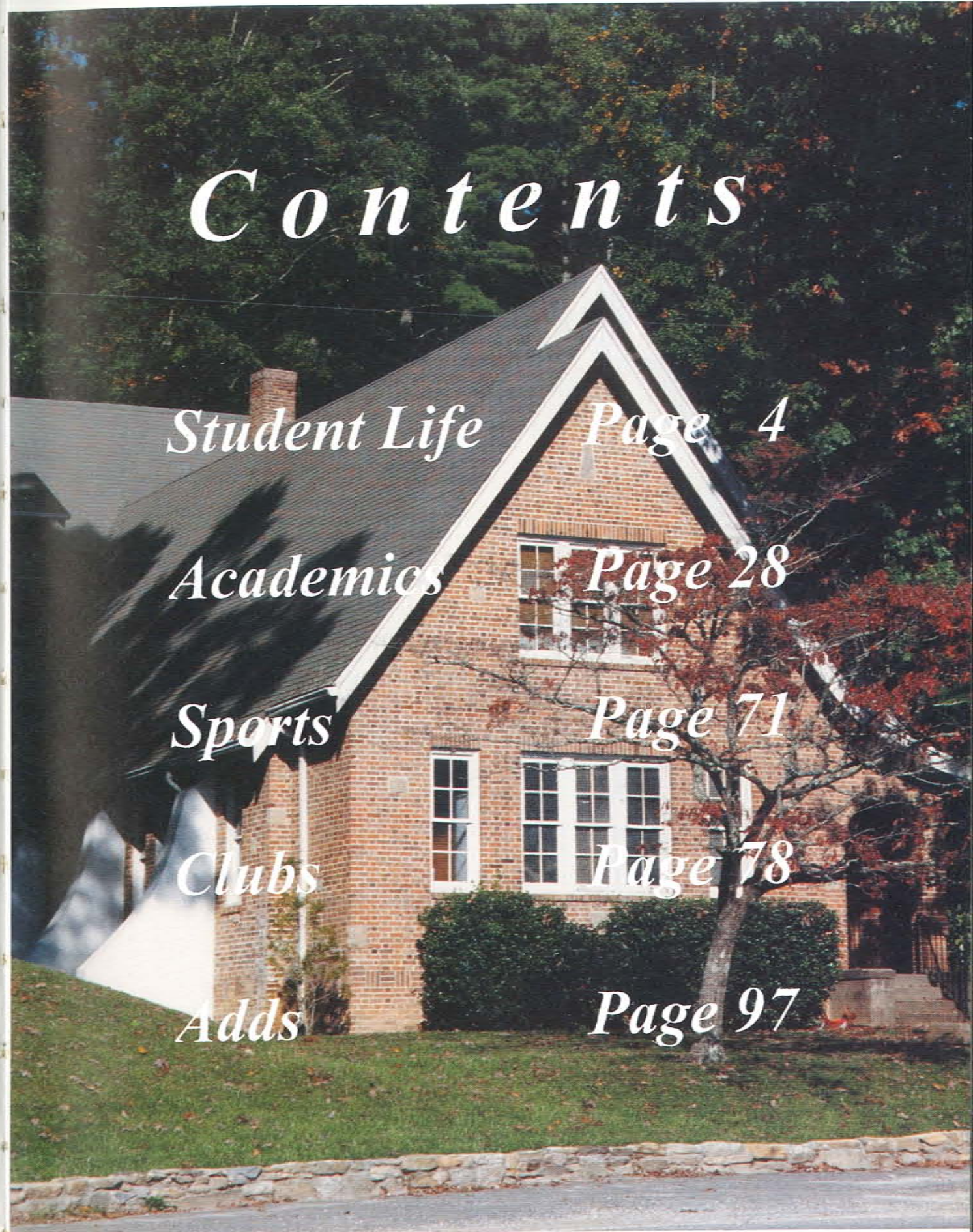

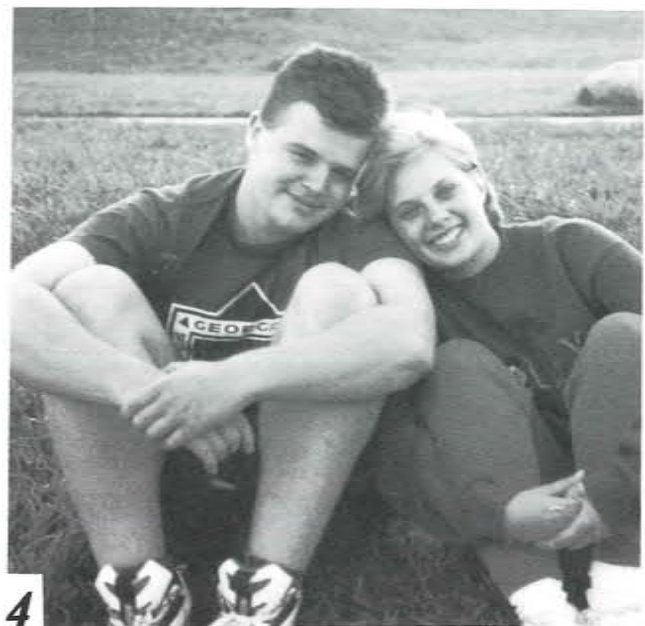

Student Life

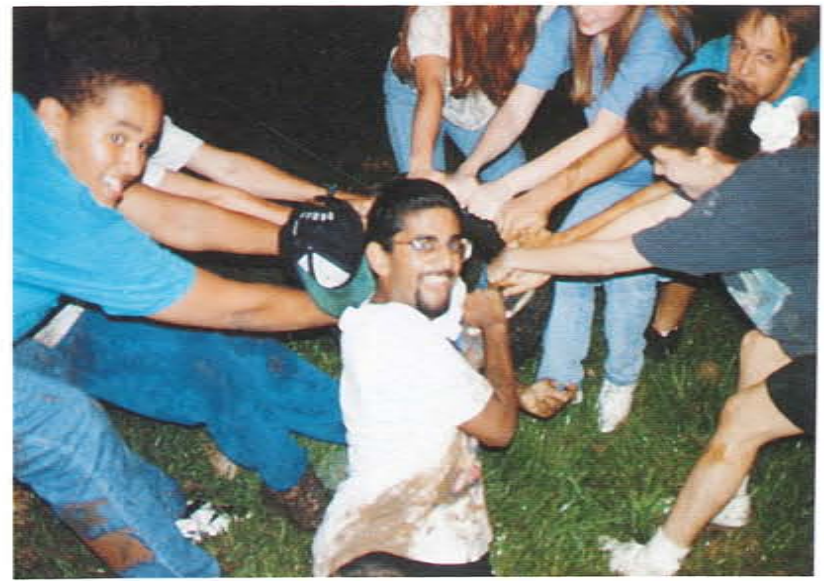

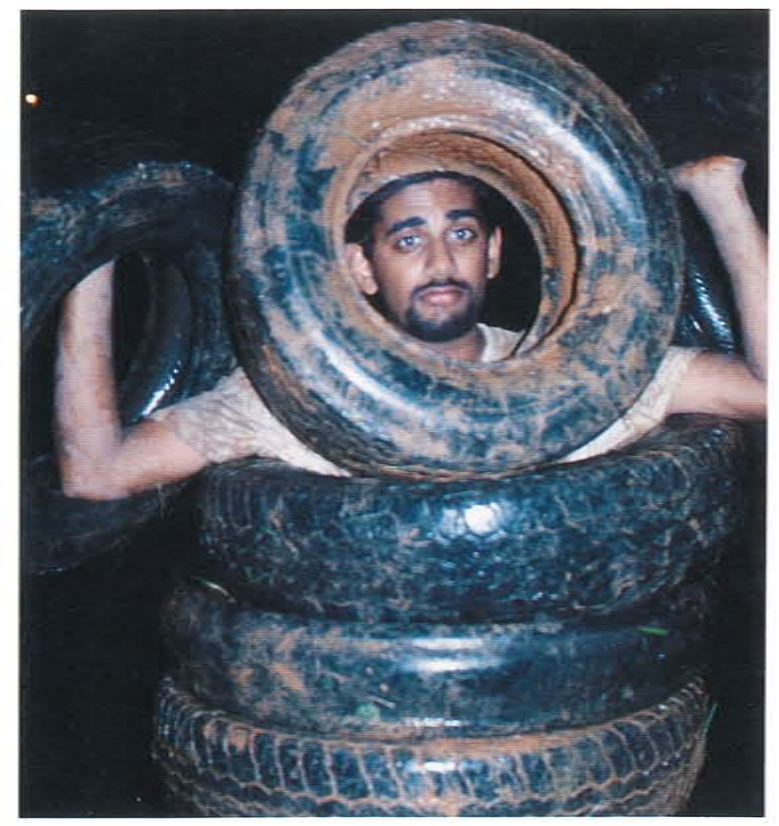

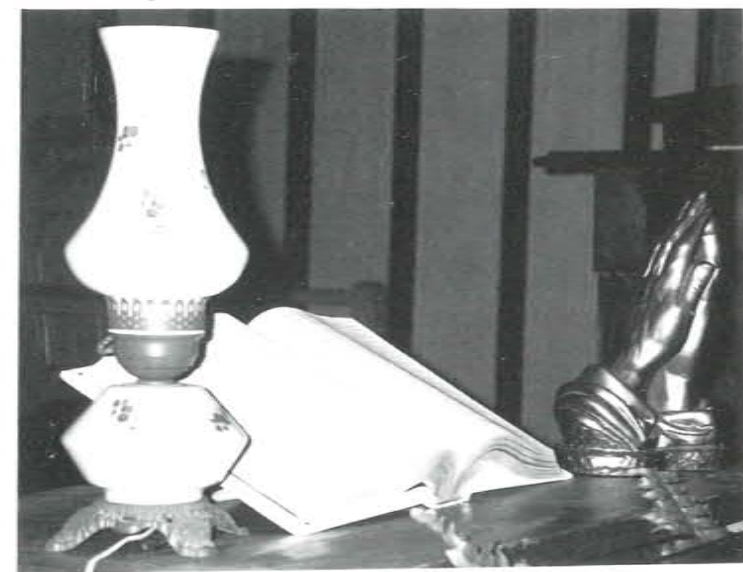


Agape Feast and Dedication

S. A. FAIR



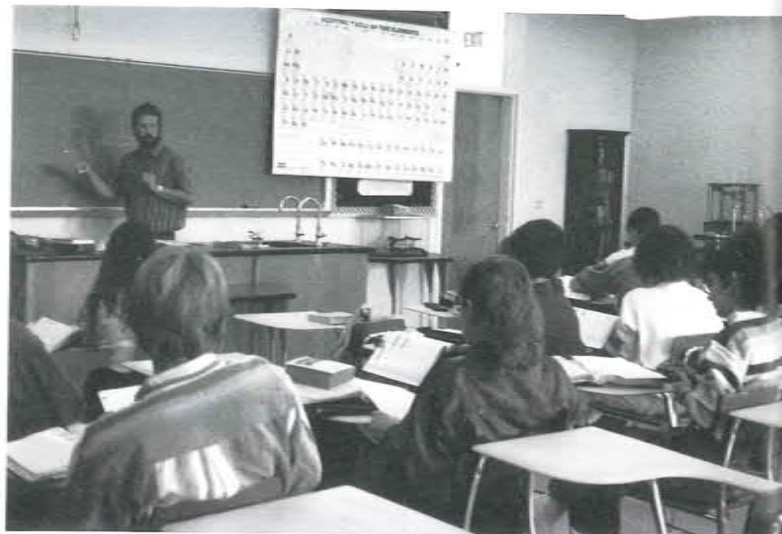
