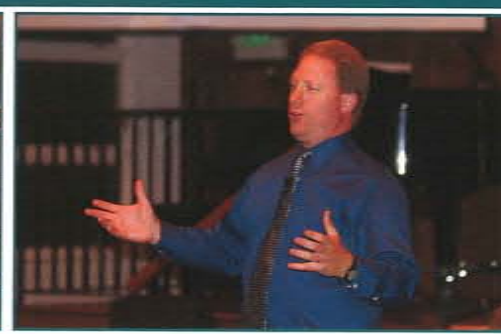


Week of Prayer
