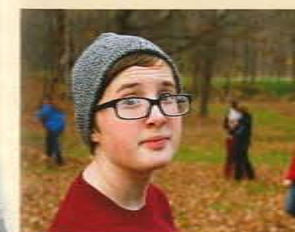
Learning in Real Life
