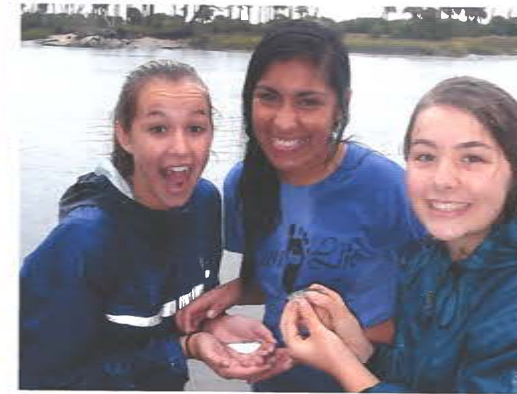


Praying Players

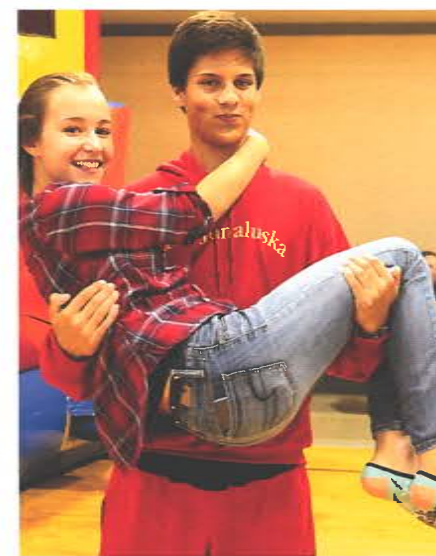
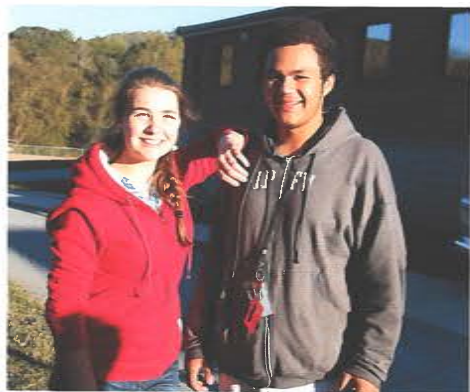
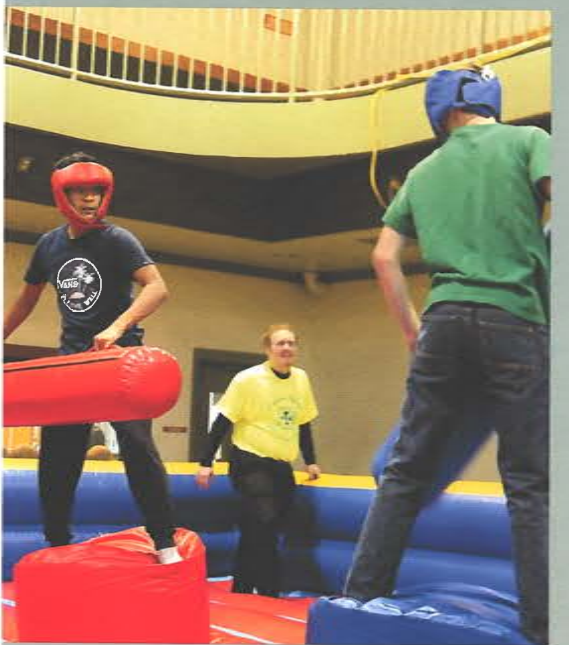


W[IN]TER

A PART OF [HISTORY]

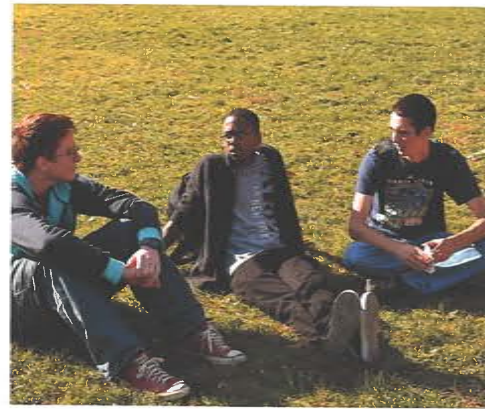

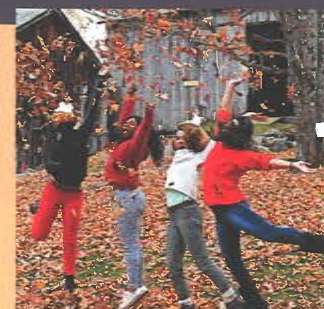

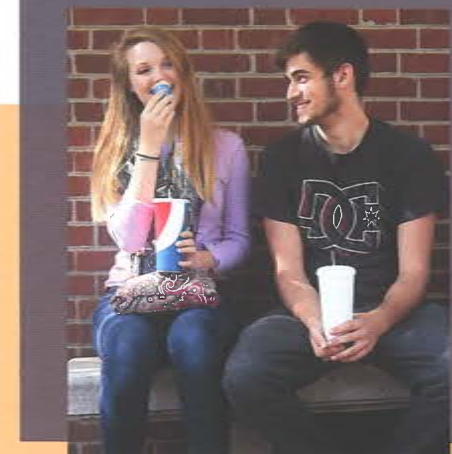
At 9:30 p.m students go to see the Lincoln Memorial. Looking over the steps to see a lit up Washington D.C. it was our first, magical night.

Just a few words, that's all it took to hook the listeners. From the beginning to the end of the week, the speakers were noticeably on fire for Christ.



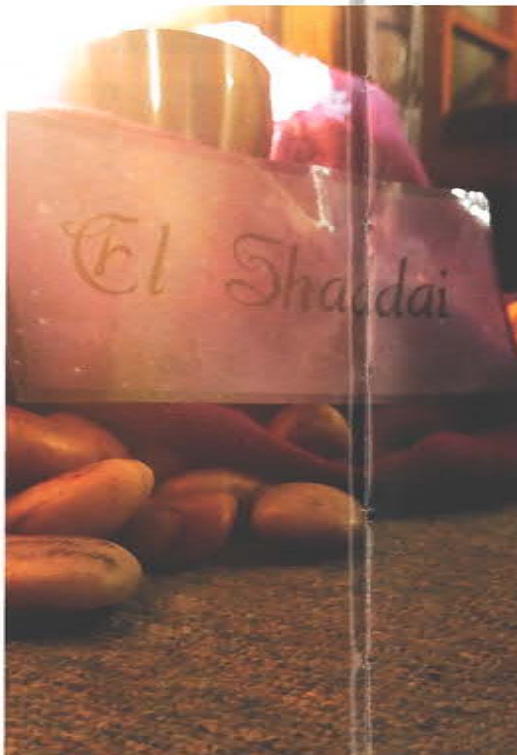
The music was another incredibly powerful aspect of the week of prayer. Each selection showed God in a different and unique way, enhancing our worship over this week.

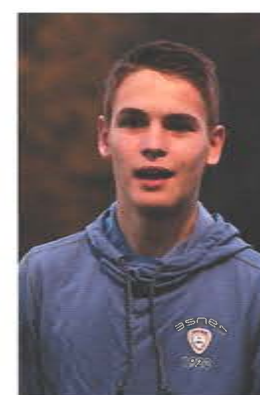


Black Friday Madness!

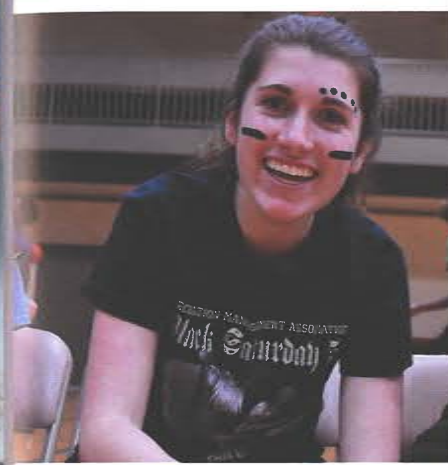
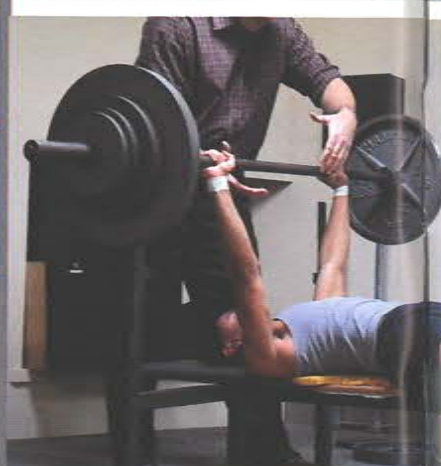
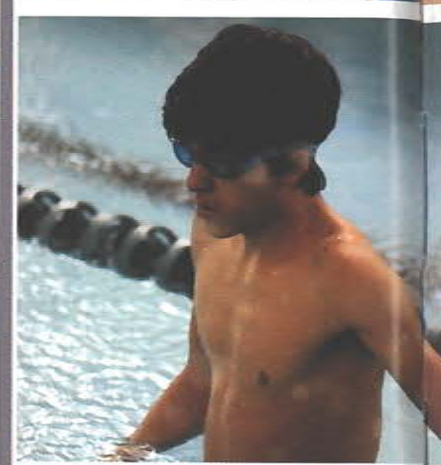
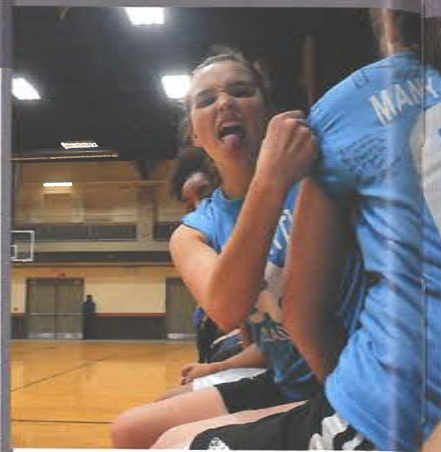
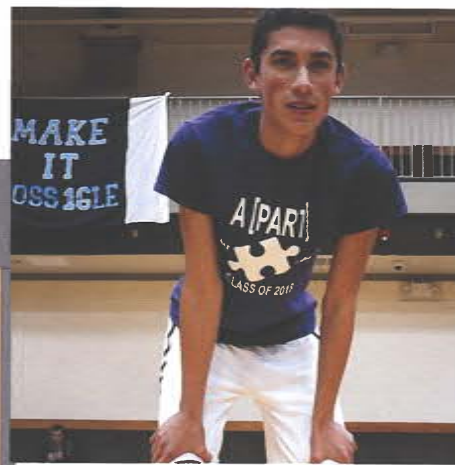
WINTER OLYMPICS

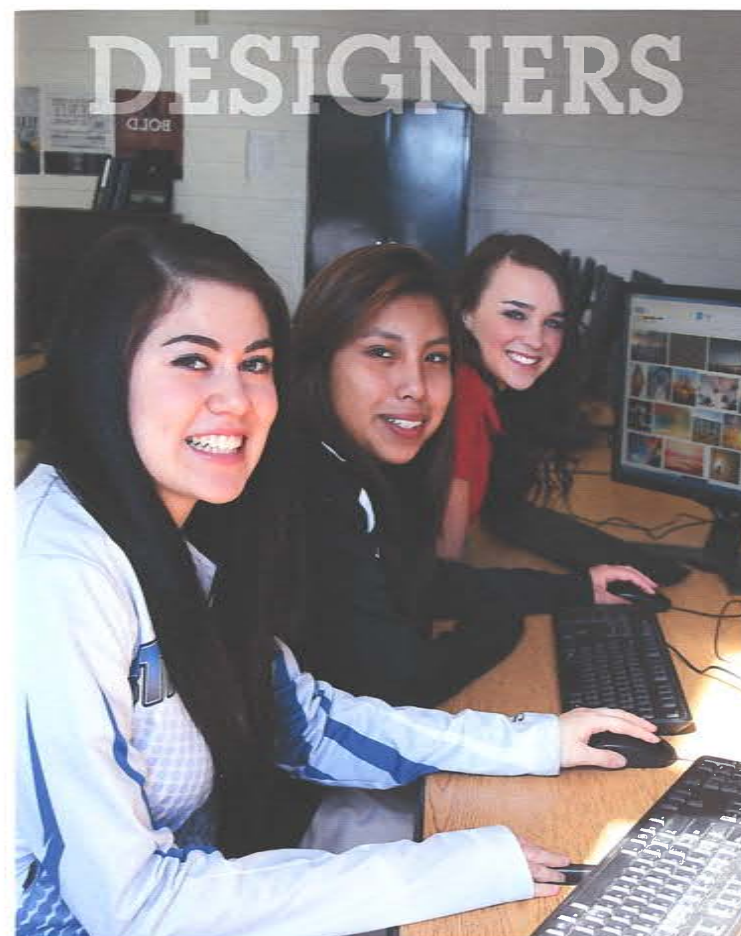
EDITOR'S ADDRESS
