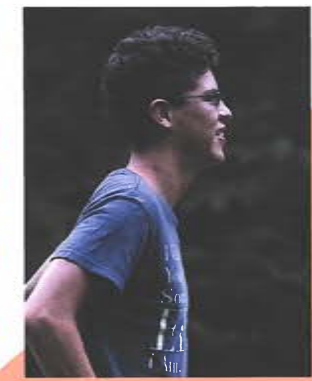

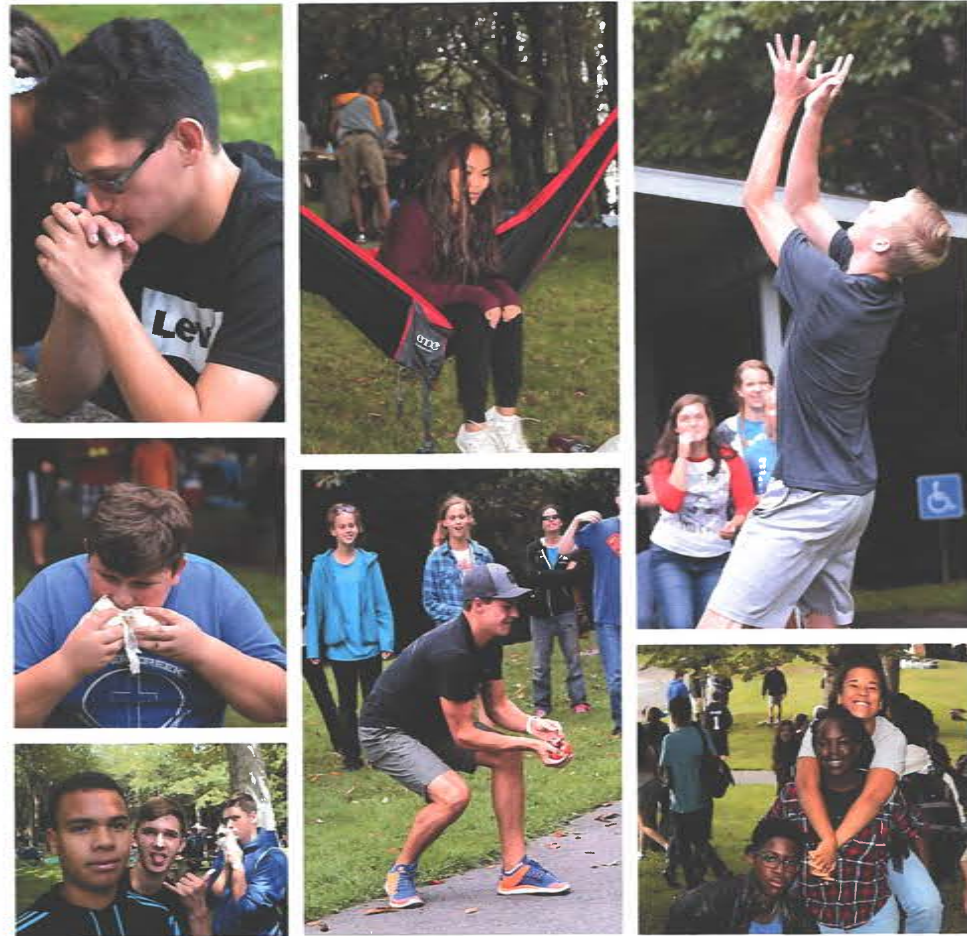
Freshman Time

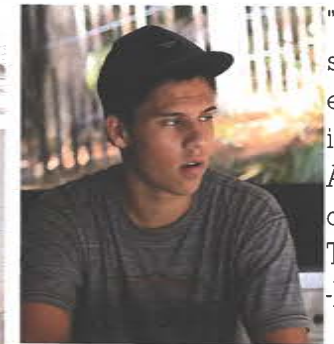
Carvill vs. Sophomores

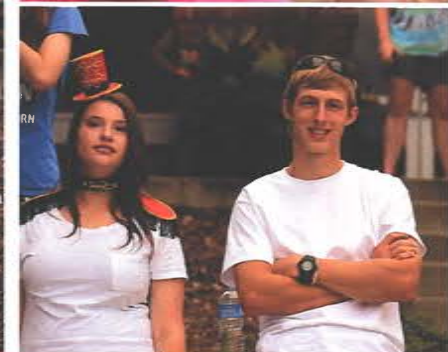
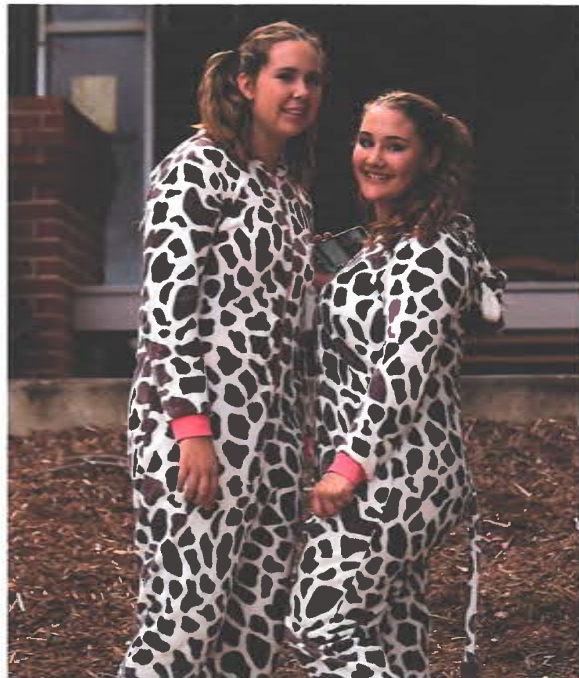
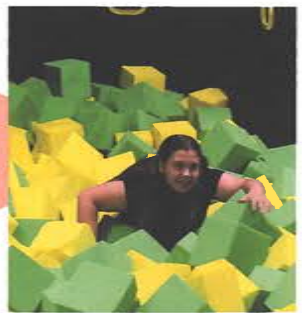


FALL FESTIVAL

Medical Clinic

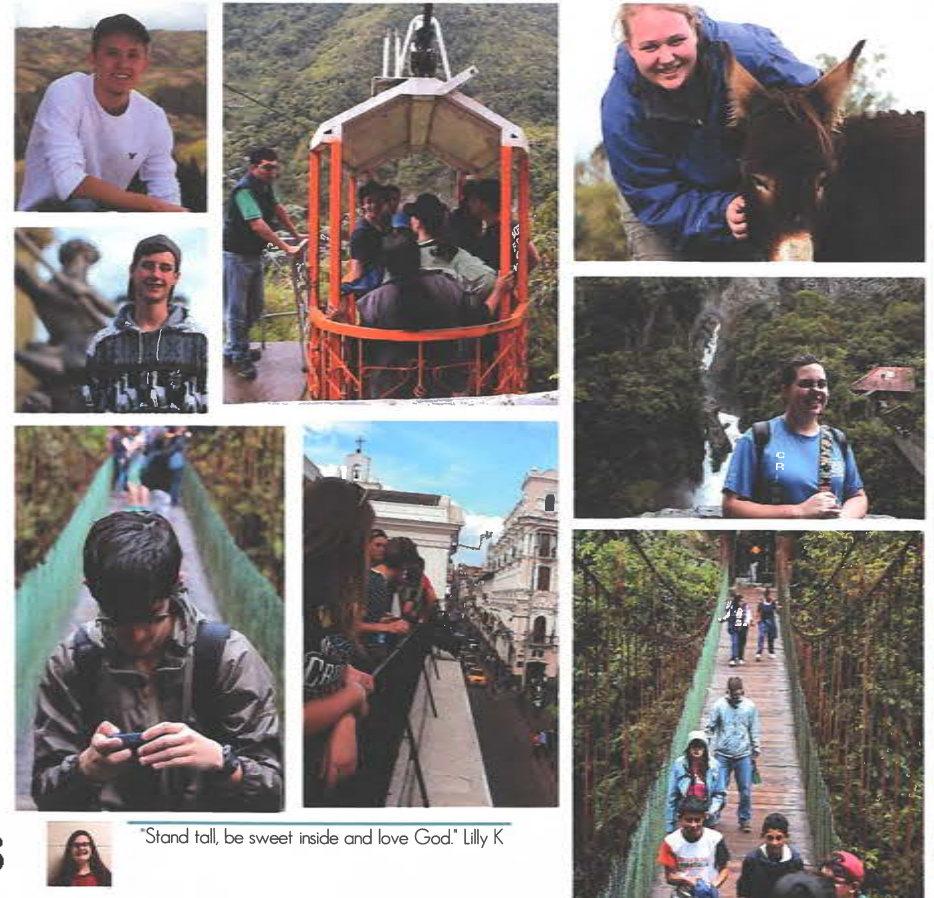

Do you have a favorite sport or sports team? Today is the day to show it off. Most students will just wear a jersey shirt, but some (**Daniel Velez**) will go all out.



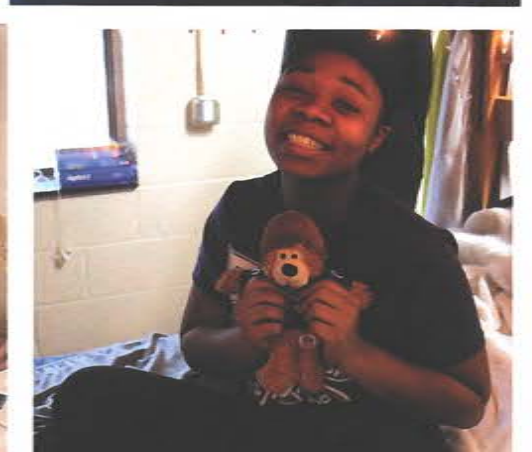
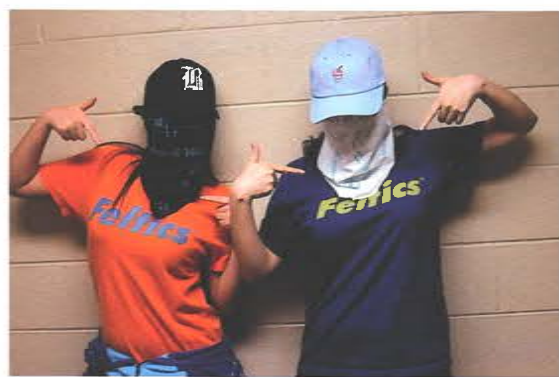
Hair Day

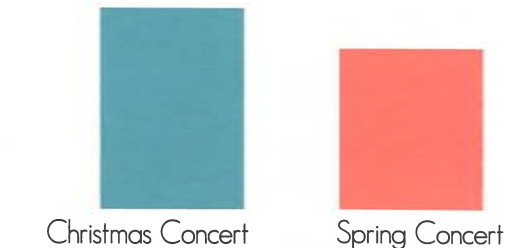


Before Performances

Life in the Student Center

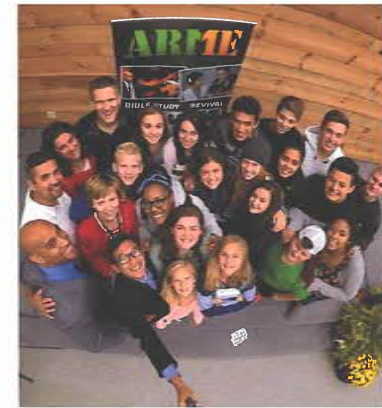

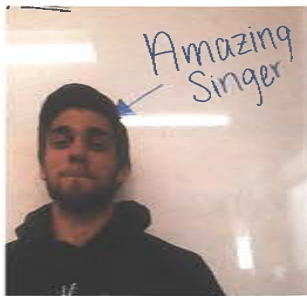
Remember That One Time.....

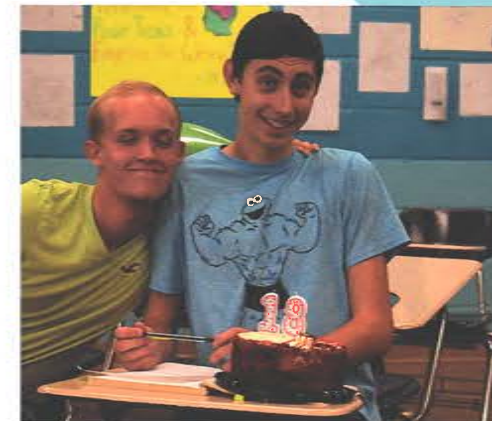
During biology trip, the weather was never the best. Every day that the sophomore class was in Charleston it rained hard on them. But they were still able to have a great time with their class.

For the last two years the seniors and sopohmores have had close competition in class on class soccer. This year did not disappoint. Again both classes played well and it was a close game' till the end.

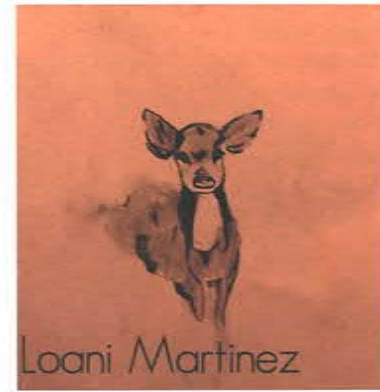
