












A Journey Through Time




Through the Eyes of a Senior






Before Performances

Pastor James is there to talk with them and play games and help them have their much needed Time With God.






Sabbath Afternoons

The Campus Ministry activites are loved by the students and are a huge blessing to whoever is involved-whether giving or receiving.








